It is with great pleasure that we would like to invite you to visit the Dept. of urology of the University Hospital in Bern, Switzerland.

Our hospital is situated in Bern, the capital of Switzerland. With its time-honoured sandstone buildings, historic towers and unique fountains, Bern is one of the finest examples of mediaeval architecture in Europe. The city's appearance has remained virtually unchanged for centuries, earning Bern a place on the UNESCO list of World Heritage Sites.

Our team covers the entire range of adult urology. One of the main interest lies in urological oncology. This division has achieved an international reputation for its surgical techniques in the treatment of prostate and bladder cancer. The orthotopic ileal neobladder (Studerbladder), was developed in our unit in Bern and is currently used worldwide, because of it's low complication rate and excellent post-operative results.

Our unit consists of three wards (45 patients), an intermediate care unit (5 patients), an outpatient clinic, four operating rooms and a stone treatment centre.

You will have the opportunity to participate in the whole treatment and nursing process. You will be able to accompany the patient to the operating room, to the intermediate care unit and to the ward. You will have the possibility to observe, how we plan nursing care from the admission to the discharge of the patient.

We would like to present you our nursing concepts of the following topics:

- Cystectomy with ileal bladder substitutes or ileal conduit
- Radical prostatectomy
- Nephrectomy
- Testicular Cancer / Chemotherapy
- TUR-P / TUR-B
- Stone treatment: ESWL/ Pyelonephrolithotomy/ Ureterorenoscopy
- Intermittent Self Catheterisation

In addition to these specific nursing topics concerning urology, you will also gain insight in general nursing practice of our University Hospital.
